### The Award is given for:

- Outstanding contribution to the promotion of Social-Understanding and Upliftment of Weaker Sections of Society
- A published work or a mass movement, widely recognized and acclaimed, which has made considerable impact on the quality of life of the weaker sections of society
- Efforts towards integrating Weaker Sections into the mainstream of Indian Society, working for their socio-economic and educational upliftment

**Work done within the period of 10 years immediately preceding the nomination shall be considered for the award**

### Nominations can be made by:

- Ministries of the Govt. of India
- State Govt. / Union Territories Administration
- Members of Parliament
- Past recipient of the award
- Former Jury Members of the Award
- Vice-Chancellors of Universities
- Social Organizations and Non-Government Organizations

**Nomination must be sent in the prescribed format, either in Hindi or English only**  
(Nominations received in other than prescribed proforma will not be entertained)
